Victoria Line to Euston and Warren Street stations.

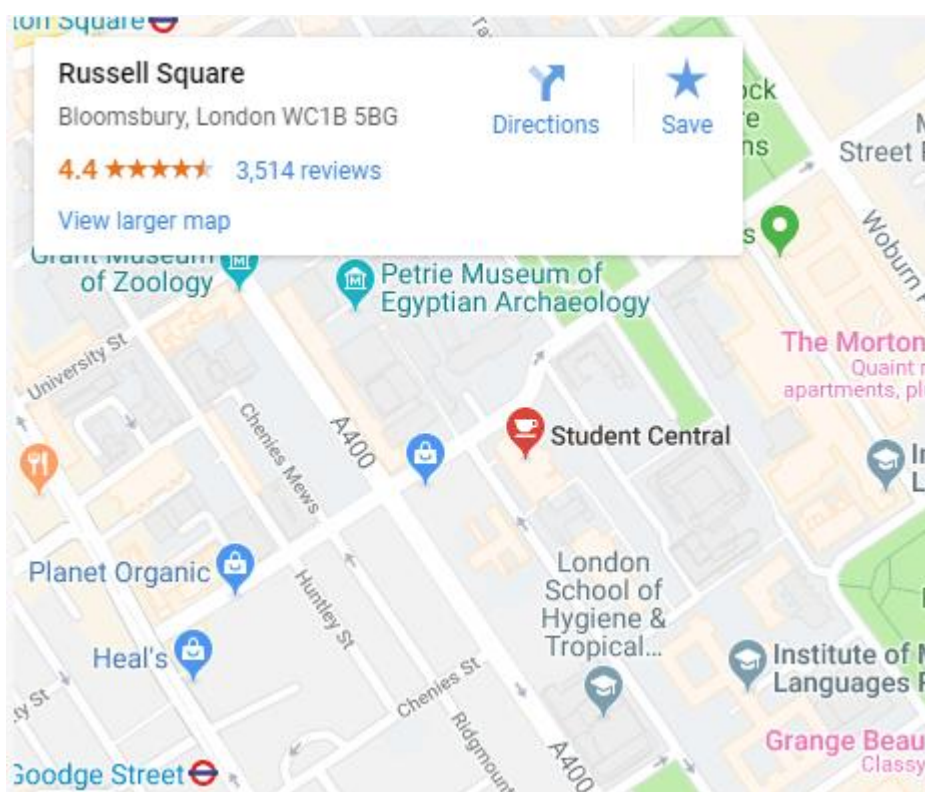
Circle, Metropolitan and Hammersmith & City Lines to Euston Square station.
