The University has a NO SMOKING POLICY throughout its facilities.

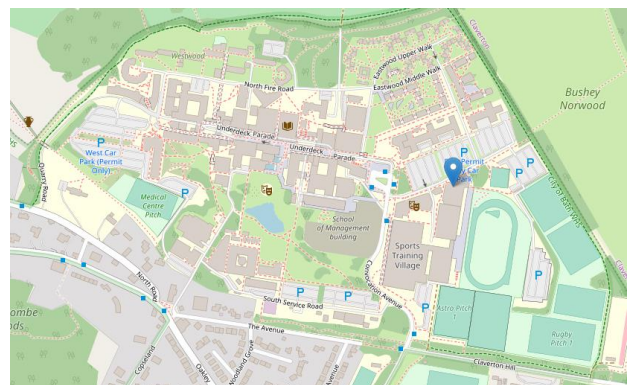
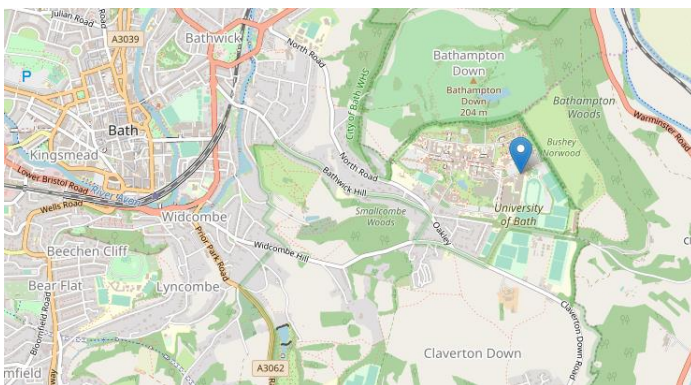
